


Beneath the Waves Border

XStitch the Rainbow







Just a few of the ways that you can use this border pattern to connect multiple Beneath the Waves designs



The empty space inside this border is 64 x 64 threads. If the design you are stitching is 60 x 60, that leaves 2 stitches between the main design and the border on all sides.

Note that not all designs are exactly 60 x 60 - use the center arrows as seen on the chart of the border to help center each design


Obviously, stitching borders will use up some thread, so plan accordingly - you might need multiple thread packs if you are stitching multiple designs with borders.





XSTITCH *the* RAINBOW

30 40 50 60 70 80



To use two borders back to back, these stitches overlap

Various options for fillings inside and outside of borders that are back to back

Or just use the borders without any fillings inside or out

How the borders meet in a corner
